**AMENDMENTS TO
BY-LAWS
Knights of Columbus
Fourth Degree
Hilton Head Assembly - 2280
Hilton Head Island, SC**

Adopted April 15, 2010

Article VII shall be amended to include the following paragraph:

“(b) An amount from members’ dues, to be determined by the Board of Trustees and approved by the members in accordance with Article XI of these by-laws, shall be credited to a separate ledger account to be known as the Seminarian Fund and be disbursed in accordance with Article X, Section 3. In addition, any reimbursement received from the Supreme Council, in connection with the Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP), shall be credited to this account.”

Article VIII, Section 2 shall be amended to read as follows:

“The Purser shall deposit all moneys received from the Comptroller in a bank to the credit of the Assembly. Disbursements from this fund shall be made either by check signed by the Faithful Navigator and Purser or by the Purser, with the approval of the Faithful Navigator, through means of electronic banking. The depository shall be furnished with a copy of this section.”

Article X shall be amended to include the following:

“Section 3. At the first business meeting of each calendar year, a list of all members, in good standing, who died during the preceding calendar year, will be compiled by the Faithful Comptroller. The Board of Trustees will then confer and make a recommendation to the Assembly as to any donation to be made from the Seminarian Fund established in Article VII, in memory of each of those members, to a seminarian or seminarians selected from a list provided by the Bishop of Charleston. Any such contribution shall take into account the then current requirements by the Supreme Council for participation in the Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP).”
