Fred was instrumental in retrieving the original meeting minutes from the archives.

When I began this research project to compile a brief history of the Hilton Head Assembly, my intention was to identify and report on at least one historical fact for each fraternal year since the first Assembly was called to order on May 21, 1992. While attempting to do so, it should be noted that all minutes up to Fraternal Year 2005/2006 were handwritten and difficult to read. Please forgive me for any names that may have been spelled incorrectly. I did my best with some handwriting that was a challenge to say the least. Contained in this brochure are facts that I have selected and presented as a representative sample for the Hilton Head Assembly. While there were many outstanding accomplishments made by each Assembly's officers and members for each Fraternal Year, the sample selected is only a glimpse of what may have happened during that year.

## ***Dear Sir Knights and Ladies:***

First of all, I would like to sincerely thank our Faithful Scribe, Sir Knight Larry Czekay, for the effort he put forth in researching and compiling this Brief History of the Hilton Head Assembly. Without his dedication and hard work this document would not exist. For those of you who may wish to pass along this brochure to your families, below is a short summary of the Knights of Columbus, the different Degrees within the Order and what the Emblem of the Fourth Degree signifies.

Father Michael J. McGivney was the assistant Pastor at St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut and is the Founder of the Knights of Columbus, which dates back to 1882. The Connecticut state legislature on March 28, 1882 officially chartered the Knights of Columbus as a fraternal benefit society, formed to provide financial aid to members and their families along with assistance to the sick and disabled.

The patron of the Order is Christopher Columbus, whose first name Christopher means Christ Bearer and Columbus means Dove of Peace. There are four Degrees within the Order: Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. Once obtaining the Fourth Degree of Patriotism, the title of Sir Knight is bestowed upon the member. Usually, the Sir Knights are seen at community or other major events and act as the visible arm of the Order. The regalia worn by Sir Knights include a tuxedo, chapeau, cape and the ceremonial sword, which symbolizes Christian Knighthood, and signifies reverence to the Roman Catholic Church, Eucharist, our country and freedom.

The emblem of the Fourth Degree is spiritually symbolic and consists of a Globe (God the Father, Creator of the Universe), a Cross (God the Son, Redeemer of mankind) and a Dove (God the Holy Spirit, Sanctifier of humanity). The colors of red, white and blue signify the colors of the country flag in which the Order originated and stresses Patriotism.

## **FY 1992/1993 HIGHLIGHTS**

The first meeting of the Knights of Columbus Fourth Degree Hilton Head, South Carolina Assembly was called to order on May 21, 1992 at Holy Family Catholic Church. There were 25-27 members in attendance. The main purpose of the meeting was to present the officers who would be elected to lead the Assembly. The first officers elected were:

Also decided at this first meeting:

- \* Meetings would be held monthly on the third Thursday.
- \* Smoking would not be allowed at meetings.
- \* Installation of officers would take place on June 2, 1992, at 7 PM at Holy Family Church.
- \* Mass would be celebrated by Father Hamilton with a reception following in the Church Hall.
- \* Cost for the buffet dinner was \$7.00.
- \* 4th Degree Charter received and will be on display in both Reilly and Bennett Councils.
- \* Jewels for Assembly will be purchased.
- \* Frederick A. Losinski appointed first Color Corps Commander.
- \* By-laws and dues were discussed. Decided dues would be \$30.
- \* Purchase of Honor Roll plaque voted on and approved.
- \* Assembly received Cross of Columbus on November 14, 1992.
